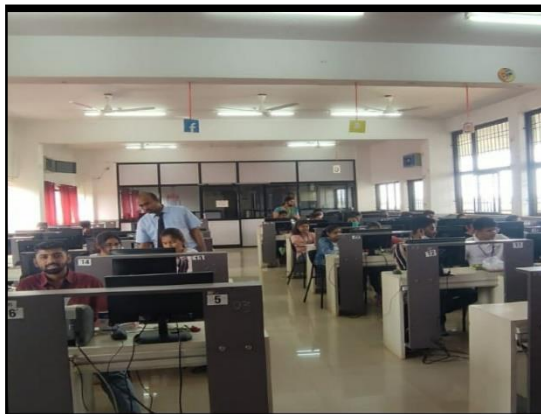
Great response received from the students. They got good knowledge of technical and other domains. Overall two-days, students enjoyed thoroughly and developed mini projects at the end of the second day

Digital Literacy and Life skills Program

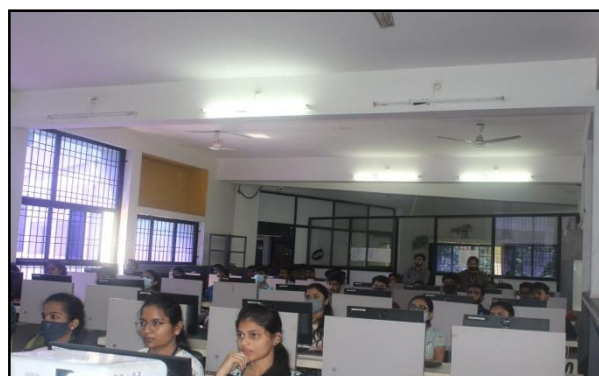
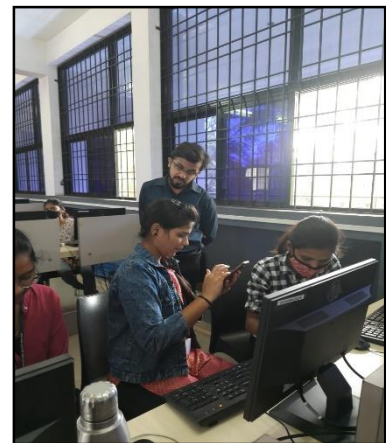

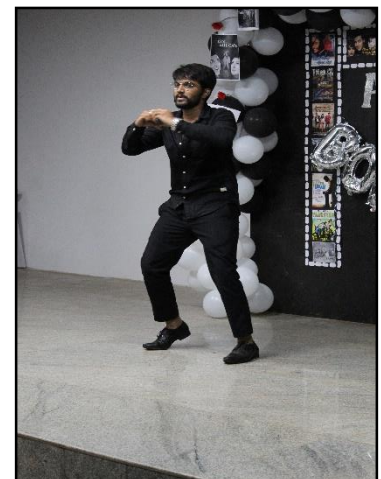
