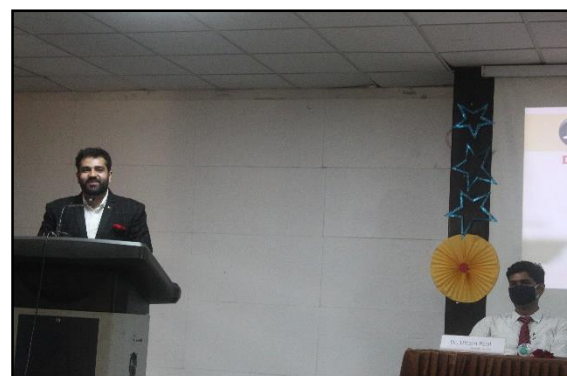
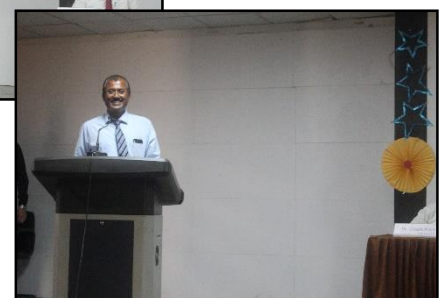
Alumni Meet (9th OCT 21)
